### Homework/Class work Policy:

### Quizzes:

Tests:

Test will be given every few weeks to evaluate your progress. Tests are usually given at the end of each chapter. Students that receive and F (59 and below) will be permitted to retake the test after school.

Warm-ups:

Warm-ups are given daily. If you are tardy you will not be able to receive points for warm-ups. If your absent is excused, you are excused from the assigned warm-up given that day.

Notes:

Notes will be written in a spiral notebook (given to students). These will be checked 1-2 times per quarter. If you are absent, you are responsible for getting the notes from another student.

Grading Policy

Grades will be based on Warm-Ups, Tests, Quizzes, Notes and Homework. There is a final exam that counts for 20% of your semester grade. Grades will be calculated based on total points earned.
