

3 D Art

- 1st week** **Rules and Expectations** Students will begin with a collage for the cover of their sketchbook.
- 2nd week** **Duo-Decahedron** Students will make a 20 sided figure with Colored construction paper and decorate the triangles that make up each side.
- 3rd-5th week** **Cardboard Sculpture** Students will design and construct a cardboard sculpture and they may use a variety of different materials to cover it. They may use paper-mache then paint it, Paper-mache then sand it, paper mache then use plaster and paint it. They should make designs for their sculptures in their sketchbooks.
- 6th week** **Artist Report** Students will work in the computer lab to research information on an artist. When the research is complete they will compile it and make a poster and present the information to the class.
- 7th-10th week** **Clay** Students will be introduced to a variety of different types of pottery, coil pots, slab pots, (both cups and boxes), and also wheel throwing. All students will have an opportunity to work on the wheel. They will learn the vocabulary for ceramics and how to use the tools necessary for the construction of the different types of pottery. They will learn the difference between ceramics and pottery. They will learn the difference between green-ware, a bisque firing, and a glaze firing. They will learn how to glaze.
- 11th -15th week** **Fiber sculpture** Students will be working on different types of fiber art. They can choose between rug hooking (they make their own design and carry it out), needlepoint, weaving, basketry, puppets, and soft sculptures. Depending what they choose to do depends on what materials they will use. No matter what they choose to do they will be working with some sort of material.
- 16th week** All projects should be completed and we will review for exams.
