

POTTERY

- 1ST week** **Rules and Expectations** Students will get their boxes and supplies they will use for the semester. They also learn where all of the other tools they will be using are located. We start designing a clay stamp to be used to identify all of our pots. We carve them out of plaster first.
- 2nd week** Finish stamps and begin slab cup. When finished with cup with start on their box. First they must make a design for their box in their sketchbooks. I will introduce the wheel sometime this week and all students will be working on the wheel at least one day a week.
- 3rd week** Finish boxes and by now should have cups bisque fired and ready to glaze. Work on the wheel, will be shown how to trim the foot.
- 4th -5th week** **Coil pots** Students will make a coil pot that is at least 12 inches high. They will put different designs on the coils. If boxes are bisque fired, they will glaze them. (Working on the wheel)
- 5th – 7th week** **Hollowed out Form** This one may take more than a week. (Working on the wheel)
- 8th week** **Vase out of a Slab** (Working on the wheel)
- 9th - 10th week** **Make a large pot** using either a slab, coil, and/or wheel construction or all three. This will take at least 2 weeks if not longer. (Working on the wheel)
- 11th –13 week** **Face Jug** Using either a coil pot or a thrown pot will make a jug with a face on it. (Working on the wheel)
- 14th -15th week** **Finish up all work.** If finished will design and make their own favorite of what we have done. (Working on the wheel)
- 16th week** **Review for exams** Clean out boxes if not having Potter II.
