PRINCIPALLY SPEAKING

Dear Parents:

It is important to remember that while it is great to let kids indulge in outdoor activities, the risk of being approached by a stranger is increased when kids spend less time in the house. A good way to help children stay away from dangerous people is to review some safety tips about strangers:

- Children should avoid people they don't know. Although most strangers are safe, some are dangerous, and you cannot tell the difference.
- Unsafe strangers can be **young, old, male or female.**
- Dangerous strangers often ask for help, like directions. They may also offer gifts like candy.
- If children are in a dangerous situation, they should **run, yell, or get help** from someone they trust like a parent or police officer.
- Children should trust themselves, and leave any situation that makes them feel uncomfortable.



Please remind your student that *anyone* they don't know is a stranger!
