As we begin the new school year, many of you are concerned about safety protocols for our students and staff. As we return to full face-to-face learning for all students, here are some of the precautionary measures we are taking:

- All students and staff will be in masks, K-12. Students at King will also wear masks where appropriate.
- Masks must be worn on the bus to and from school.
- Masks are not required on the playground or in the cafeteria while eating.
- Students will be temperature checked at the entry to our schools.
- Please keep your child home if they are not feeling well or exhibit symptoms of COVID. We are requesting that you self-screen your child before sending them to school.
- We will use disinfectant, and social distancing to the extent possible. With everyone in a mask, social distance requirements fall from 6 ft to 3 ft.
- Vaccines will be available with an appointment at our Health Clinic, which operates at our Secondary Campus.
